The Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools (“OBPVS”) is pleased to document that **AHRE’s** application for a new school license to offer and to provide distance education for Oklahoma residents has been approved. Students do not have to have a High School Diploma or Equivalency, but if under age 18 must have the Enrollment Agreement signed by a Parent/Guardian. In addition, the Student may not test for Court Certification until age 18. **This letter revises and supersedes the prior letter issued February 26, 2026, but does not alter the February 23, 2026 Licenses effective date.**

This license is provided and granted in accordance with **70 O.S. §21-101, et seq.**, and the Rules in **OAC 565:1** and **565:10**. The current license remains in effect for the period of February 23, 2026 through June 30, 2026, unless revoked for cause. This State Authorization permits AHRE to make the following Program available for the length beginning on February 23, 2026 to the eligible students as described in the first paragraph.

AHRE charges the Tuition on a, “Pay as you go basis,” one (1) class at a time. Specific, individual class costs are shown on page 1 of the Catalog, effective 2/23/2026.

Additional Program costs are payable to a third-party vendor(s) of the Student’s choosing. Those costs are not paid to **AHRE**. Equipment, software, and books will be rented or purchased through a third-party vendor(s) who is **solely** responsible for setting its costs. **The average current pricing, the responsibility of the Student, as of 2/23/2026 was:**

<sup>1</sup> Tuition includes twelve (12) months of Speed-Building at \$250/Month, but the total necessary Speed-Building length to be prepared for Certification varies with the individual Student.

<sup>2</sup> The first ninety (90) days of Software use are free.

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The present **Oklahoma Supreme Court CSR Testing** requires the applicant to accomplish 220 Words Per Minute, with 95% Accuracy. Achieving those competencies requires different lengths of practice for each individual.

### Licensing Precautions and Ongoing Compliance

1. In Oklahoma, prior to OBPVS approval, any Degree program contemplated in the future must first have State Authorization issued by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
2. **AHRE** is required to notify this office of any change in ownership, administration, location, faculty, instructional program, tuition, or any other change that may affect the instruction offered in Oklahoma. Such change notification is usually required **before** a change is implemented to allow for **advance OBPVS review and approval** of the proposed change.
3. **AHRE** is hereby alerted that an OBPVS School License does not convey training privileges in any other State. That is, the OBPVS License does not assure Private (Proprietary) School permission to operate outside of Oklahoma. Other States' laws may require a separate, State-specific application to be made and approved to offer Court Reporting training, even by distance ed. transmitted from outside that state. 4. **OAC 565:3-1** (in the Rules) requires, "To apply for license in Oklahoma, an Applicant or school shall be in compliance and maintain compliance with Federal, State, or local laws, rules, and ordinances. When a standard(s) differ between the OBPVS and an accrediting agency, the Applicant or school subjects itself to the most stringent of the alternate standards and agrees to maintain compliance with the most stringent standard."
